Cost- \$4,892.30

Supply item 2- Training costs for department-wide Taser training. Includes cost of instruction and training materials as well as personnel cost associated with attendance.

Cost- \$1205.70

Supply item 3- Three (3) FoRS Record Management System (RMS) software licenses and prorated Annual Maintenance and Support fee for our three Mobile Data Computers to access our in-hours RMS.

Cost- \$1,780.00

Supply item 4- Netgear Wireless VPN Firewall Router with VPN Client Software. Includes installation and configuration.

Cost- \$840.00

Supply item 5- Acer 10.1 inch Netbook with portable optical drive and case.

Cost- \$474.00

Supply item 6- TraCs Scanner Kits (3) to be used to electronically complete traffic citations and accident reports.
