

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-6

**AMENDING SECTION 390.05 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF RICHLAND CENTER RELATING TO PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATING CHAPTER 390 REGULATING DEMOLITION SITES AND
DAMAGED BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CITY**

The Common Council of the City of Richland Center, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I:

Section 390.05 of the Code of ordinances of the City of Richland Center is amended to read as follows:

390.05 PENALTIES.

(1) Any person, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, voluntary association or other legal entity who shall violate or fail or refuse to comply with any section of this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit to the City of Richland Center not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$400.00, plus all applicable costs, fees and surcharges imposed under Ch. 814 Wis. Stats., and in the event such forfeiture, costs, fees and surcharges are not paid, such person, any partner of such partnership, or any officer, director or managing member of any corporation or limited liability company or any officer of such voluntary association may, upon order of the Circuit Court, be imprisoned in the Richland County jail until such forfeiture, costs and assessment are paid, but not to exceed 90 days, or may be subject to any other sanctions lawfully imposed by the Court for such failure to pay. Each day that a violation is maintained or permitted to exist shall constitute a separate violation.

(2) The imposition of a forfeiture pursuant to par. (1) above shall not be deemed to constitute a waiver by the City of Richland Center of any right it may have to proceed via legal action to seek injunctive relief or to pursue any other legal remedy under the laws of the State of Wisconsin or under any other provision of any ordinance of the City of Richland Center for abatement of a nuisance, for damages or to otherwise deal with properties in violation of this Chapter or of any other provision of any ordinance or of state law.

SECTION II:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
