

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-7

**PROHIBITING POSSESSION OF GLASS CONTAINERS OR
DEPOSITING REFUSE ON NAVIGABLE WATERS WITHIN THE CITY**

The Common Council of the City of Richland Center, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1:

Chapter 229 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Richland Center is adopted to read as follows:

CHAPTER 229

**POSSESSION OF GLASS CONTAINERS OR LEAVING REFUSE ON
NAVIGABLE WATERS PROHIBITED**

229.01 Prohibitions.

(1) No person may possess any glass container in or on any navigable waters within the City of Richland Center.

(2) No person may deposit or leave any trash, garbage, litter, rubbish, debris, waste material or refuse of whatever nature in or on any navigable waters within the City of Richland Center.

229.02 Definition. "Navigable waters" means any body of water which is navigable under the laws of the State of Wisconsin and specifically includes the Pine River.

229.03 Penalty. Any person who shall violate this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit to the City of Richland Center not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$400.00, plus all applicable costs, fees and surcharges imposed under Ch. 814 Wis. Stats., and in the event such forfeiture, costs, fees and surcharges are not paid, such person upon order of the Circuit Court, be imprisoned in the Richland County jail until such forfeiture, costs and assessment are paid, but not to exceed 90 days, or may be subject to any other sanctions lawfully imposed by the Court for such failure to pay.


SECTION 2:
