


RICHLAND CENTER PARKS MAP

1) Krouskop Park: 37.5 acres
Playground equipment, areas for picnicking, swimming pool, 2 lighted baseball/softball diamonds, basketball court, 3 lighted tennis courts, 2 sand volleyball courts, 8 shelters, restrooms, access to fishing and canoeing of the Pine River.

2) North Park: 12.5 acres
Two lighted baseball/softball diamonds, two new youth baseball fields, several soccer fields, a picnic shelter along with a double shelter for concessions, playground equipment and picnicking.

3) North Lake Park: 3.5 acres
Stocked pond with a variety of pan fish, gazebos, playground equipment and picnicking.

4) Strickland Park: 3 acres
Playground equipment, picnicking and access to Minor Hill hiking trails.

5) Minor Hill Trails Park: 50 acres
A walking and hiking trail that has 5 scenic overlooks to the City of Richland Center. Trail complete with signs and areas for picnicking.

6) Westside Park: 3 acres
Playground equipment and scenic picnic areas near a historic wood walking bridge.

7) Wedgewood N/S: 30 acres
Two parks that include parking, picnic tables, benches and walking trails.

8) Community/Senior Center
*New location at Krouskop Park. An all-purpose facility that can be rented for all activities. Activities include: auctions, rummage sales, receptions, civic events, public meetings and much more.

9) City Arboretum: 4 acres
Plantings of over 120 different species of trees and shrubs, along the bike trail.

10) City Canoe Ports/Walking Trails
Five canoe ports along the scenic Pine River with walking trail developed by two Eagle Scouts.
