

STREET MAINTENANCE WORKER

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Performs a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled tasks involving the maintenance and repair of city streets, parking lots, and other city property in Richland Center; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Employees in this class are responsible for the maintenance and repair of city streets, lots, and walkways. The work involved is of an unskilled or semiskilled nature which does not require special previous training or experience, work is usually performed under the direct supervision of a lead worker or the Street Department Superintendent from instructions that are received at the beginning of each new job.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative only)

Patches holes and cracks in the streets as needed; Plows snow, spreads sand and salt;

Mows grass on city property;

Operates equipment such as dumptruck, front end loader, snow blower, or street sweeper as needed for hauling gravel, black top, trash, brush, and debris or for snow removal; Paints markings and lines on streets, curbs, and parking spaces; Trims trees and removes branches and limbs;

Assists in resurfacing city streets by mixing blacktop, spreading gravel and oil, drilling holes, and tearing up old pavement; Paints, erects, and repairs signs and sign posts as needed; Changes oil, greases, and performs minor repairs on trucks and other highway equipment;

Does related work as required.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES: Good knowledge of general roadwork maintenance, repair, tools, and equipment; good knowledge of the occupational hazards involved and the safety precautions necessary in performing maintenance and repair work on city streets, skill in the use and care of tools and equipment used in general maintenance, construction and repair work; ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions; ability to perform heavy physical labor under all weather conditions.

ACCEPTABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING: Some experience in performing general maintenance work and in the operation of equipment: or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid Wisconsin Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with air brake endorsement or ability to obtain said license within 30 days after hiring date.
