

## CHAPTER 222

### DAMAGE TO PROPERTY PROHIBITED

[History: Ord 222]

**222.01** (1) It shall be unlawful to intentionally cause damage to the physical property of another without the person's consent.

(2) It shall be unlawful to intentionally cause damage to any physical property owned by the City of Richland Center, or to any physical property maintained by the City of Richland Center for the use, benefit or assistance of the general public.

(3) Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall upon conviction thereof forfeit to the City of Richland Center not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$400.00 as adjudged by the Court, plus the costs of prosecution as taxed and assessed by the Court, and any applicable penalty assessment, and in default of payment of said forfeiture and costs and penalty assessment shall be imprisoned in the County Jail of Richland County for such period of time but not to exceed 90 days as shall be adjudged by the Court unless said forfeiture, costs and penalty assessment are sooner paid.
