

CHAPTER 630

ALLOTING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF STREETS FOR SIDEWALK PURPOSES

[History: Ord 8-1887]

630.01 A strip of land on the outer edge of each side of every public street in the City of Richland Center of the number of feet in width hereinafter designated is hereby allotted for sidewalk purposes:

- (1) Along Church Street from Haseltine Street to Mill Street ten feet in width.
- (2) Along Central Avenue from Haseltine Street to Mill Street ten feet in width.
- (3) Along Main Street from Seminary Street to Main Street ten feet in width.
- (4) Along Haseltine Street from Main Street to Church Street ten feet in width.
- (5) Along Seminary Street from Main Street to Park Street ten feet in width.
- (6) Along Court Street from Main Street to Park Street ten feet in width.
- (7) Along all other streets a strip of land eight feet in width.

630.02 Said lands allotted for sidewalk purposes shall be upon such public streets and shall extend the said width from the outer line of said streets toward the center thereof.

CHAPTER 632

REGULATING PUBLIC TRAVEL ON PARK STREET

632.01 All public travel except that of pedestrians on that portion of Park Street in the City of Richland Center extending south from Court Street is hereby limited and restricted on that portion of said street above mentioned to a roadway not exceeding thirty-six (36) feet wide, and the center of said roadway is to be on and along the center of said street.

632.02 The owners of land adjacent to that portion of Park Street above described, are hereby granted the privilege to improve and beautify for ornamental purposes only, that portion of said street, lying opposite their respective premises and extending from the marginal line of said roadbed [to the marginal line of said roadbed] to the marginal line of that portion of the street allotted for sidewalk purposes.

CHAPTER 633

REGULATING PUBLIC TRAVEL ON PEARL STREET

[History: Ord 142-1914]

633.01 All public travel, except that of pedestrians, on that portion of Pearl Street in the City of Richland Center, extending from Third Street to First Street is limited and restricted to a roadway not exceeding twenty-six feet in width, and the center of said roadway is to be on and along the center of said street effective July 20, 1914.

633.02 The owners of land adjacent to that portion of Pearl Street, above described are hereby granted the privilege to improve and beautify, for ornamental purposes, only that portion of said street lying opposite their respective premises, and extending from the marginal line of said road bed, to the marginal line of that portion of the street allotted for sidewalk purposes.
