

ORDINANCE 2015 - 6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 399 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF RICHLAND CENTER RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF "CLASS A" LICENSES LIMITED TO CIDER

The Common Council of the City of Richland Center, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1:

Paragraph 399.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Richland Center is adopted to read:

(1a) "Cider" means any alcohol beverage that is obtained from the fermentation of the juice of apples or pears and that contains not less than 0.5 percent alcohol by volume and not more than 7.0 percent alcohol by volume. "Cider" includes flavored, sparkling, and carbonated cider.

SECTION 2:

Subparagraph 399.04(1) (am) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Richland Center is adopted to read:

(am) Retail "Class A" Intoxicating Liquor License Limited to Cider. A retail "Class A" intoxicating liquor license limited to cider, when issued by the City Clerk under the authority of the Common Council, shall permit its holder to sell, deal, and traffic only in cider as defined in sec. 125.51(2) (e) 1 Wis. Stats. only in original packages or containers which are to be consumed off the premises so licensed.

SECTION 3:

Subparagraph 399.15(1) (e) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Richland Center is adopted to read:

(e) "Class A" license limited to cider. Upon application, the Common Council shall grant and issue a "Class A" license to the applicant if all of the following apply:


1. The application is made for a "Class A" license containing the condition that retail sales of intoxicating liquor are limited to cider.
2. The applicant holds a Class "A" license issued under s. 125.25 for the same premises for which the "Class A" license application is made.
3. In this paragraph, "cider" means any alcohol beverage that is obtained from the fermentation of the juice of apples or pears and that contains not less than 0.5 percent alcohol by volume and not more than 7.0 percent alcohol by volume. "Cider" includes flavored, sparkling, and carbonated cider.
4. A person issued a "Class A" license under this sub. (e). may not make retail sales, or

provide taste samples, of any intoxicating liquor other than cider unless they also hold a regular "Class A" license.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
