

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The City of Richland Center will receive sealed bids on a Single Prime Contract for the Richland Center New Aquatics Facility project located at 1055 N. Orange Street, Richland Center, Wisconsin 53581, for:

The construction of a new aquatics facility which will include a Bathhouse, Equipment Building, and Aquatics facilities. Demolition of existing Bathhouse and Aquatic Facilities will be by owner and completed prior to construction start.

The Bathhouse is a 4,346 sf masonry shell building with masonry and wood stud framed interior walls. Roof construction is pre-engineered wood truss with asphalt shingles. Exterior finishes are masonry with engineered wood fascia and metal soffits. The Equipment Building is a 1,178 sf wood frame building with pre-engineered wood trusses and asphaltic shingle roof. The building has wood frame interior walls, combination concrete plank and steel grate flooring and partial equipment basement. Exterior finishes are ribbed metal panel to match existing adjacent City Parks and Grounds facility. Footings and foundations on both buildings are concrete frost and basement wall construction with concrete slab on grade. The buildings are unheated and unconditioned to be used seasonally.

Aquatic facilities will include a zero entry pool basin combined with a recreation and diving pool basin and a lazy river. Features will include water slides with related stair tower structure, splash pad area, lounge deck and grill area. Site amenities include aquatic deck area with sub-surface drainage and chain link fencing.

A pre-bid meeting is scheduled for 10:00 am local time, Thursday, April 4<sup>th</sup> at the Richland Center Community Center, adjacent to the project site, located at 1050 N. Orange Street, Richland Center, WI. **Attendance by general contract bidders is mandatory.** Subcontractors may attend.

### GENERAL BID INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS:

1. Late Bids will not be accepted.
2. No Bid proposal may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the bid opening without the consent of the Owner.
3. Bidders will be required to provide Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond for a sum no less than 5 percent of the Bid Amount.
4. Bids shall be on a Stipulated Sum basis. Segregated bids will not be accepted.
5. Submit your bid offer on the Bid Form provided. Bidders may supplement this form with attachments as appropriate. Deliver bids in an opaque envelope addressed to the City of Richland Center and labeled "Sealed Bid – Richland Center New Aquatics Facility." Incorporate the name and address of the bidder on the outside of the envelope.
6. General Contract bidders are required to prequalify to the requirements described in Document 00 2113 - Instructions to Bidders. Any contractor whose name appears on the State of Wisconsin's Debarred List shall be ineligible.
7. The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, and to waive technicalities in any bid or part thereof and to accept the bid or bids deemed to be in the cities best interest.
8. The Owner is a tax exempt entity.
