

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 101.14 (1) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF RICHLAND CENTER RELATING TO THE USE OF SCHOOL BUS RED WARNING LIGHTS

The Common Council of the City of Richland Center, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I:

Section 101.14 (1) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Richland Center is amended to read:


(1) WARNING LIGHT USE REQUIRED AT UNCONTROLLED LOCATIONS.

Notwithstanding the provisions of sec. 346.48(2)(b)2., Wisconsin Statutes, adopted by reference in Section 101.01 of this Code to the contrary, and except as provided in par. 101.14 (2), school bus operators shall use flashing red warning lights in a residence or business district when pupils or other authorized passengers are to be loaded or unloaded at a location at which there are no traffic signals and such persons must cross the street or highway before being loaded or after being unloaded.

SECTION II: Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
