We continue to monitor the recommendations from the CDC and follow the guidelines set by the State of Wisconsin and Richland County. The information continues to be fluid with frequent changes, but we are committed to this evolving process.

We want you to have confidence in your time with us to focus on the family memories instead of the worry. We feel it's important to give you as much information as possible about the things we are doing to ensure your safety.

### **Pool Hours: limited for social distancing and cleaning**

#### **Monday – Friday:**

Staff Daily Cleaning prior to each day.

Adult Swim / Lazy River Walking 11am-12pm

Open Swim 12:30-3pm (Session 1)

Staff Clean / Disinfecting 3-3:30pm

Open Swim 3:30-6pm (Session 2)

#### **Saturday – Sunday**

Staff Daily Cleaning prior to each day.

Open Swim 12:30-3pm (Session 1)

Staff Clean / Disinfecting 3-3:30pm

Open Swim 3:30-6pm (Session 2)

**\*Patrons with a Season Pass/Punch Card will be able to enter the Aquatic Center at approximately 12:15pm and 3:15 prior to each session.**

## **Entrance Fee**

- Cost is \$2.50 per session. 3 and under are free. There are two sessions per day. Exact cash is preferred.
- Traditional Season Passes will be honored. They can be purchased online or at the community center.
- Daily Punch cards will be available for purchase online or at the community center. Each pass is \$25 for 10 punches with one punch per session. Maximum of 2 cards can be purchased at a time. The purpose of the punch card is to minimize exchange of money.
- Guests are encouraged to go online to the parks and recreation website and purchase passes or punch cards. Passes and punch can be purchased at the Aquatic Center by cash or check.

## **Information for our Guests (Covid-19)**

- The danger of exposure to Covid-19 exists. These rules have been put into place for your safety. By visiting our facility, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

## **Guest Rules and Recommendations**

- Maintain a physical distance of 6 feet with anyone you do not live with while in the pool, on the pool deck, or waiting in line for concessions.
- Face masks are highly encouraged.
- Maintain proper hygiene such as covering coughs and sneezes, washing hands, and staying home if you are sick.
- Wash your hands frequently and for 20 seconds. There will be hand sanitizer available. We recommend you use it when you enter and exit.
- Respect and listen to our "Wellness Host" This person will communicate safety initiatives along with monitoring the number of patrons per session.
- When using the Lazy River, you must be in your tube at all times unless you are doing resistance walking. The number of tubes available will be restricted.
- It is encouraged to arrive dressed for pool activities.
- Actively supervise your children 8 and under.
- The concession stand will be available but followed by safety protocols.
- Deck furniture is available but encouraged to social distance when in use.
- Follow the markings on the deck area, diving board, slide steps, and concession stand as a guide for social distancing.

## **Safety Precautions**

- Customer Capacity will be reduced to 50% which is 269 people. This will start when the pool opens and will continue to be evaluated. Patrons will be denied entry once the maximum capacity for social distancing has been reached. This will limit the number of patrons for each session. This may change as recommended.
- Plexi-glass dividers will be present at our admissions counter and concessions area.
- Transaction areas will be cleaned as needed.
- Patrons are encouraged to sanitize hands with hand sanitizer before entering the pool area.
- There will be increased frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of high touch areas such as handrails, door handles, restroom surfaces, handwashing stations, diaper-changing stations, and showers.
- Cleaning supplies will include soap and water as well as an EPA approved disinfectant for Covid-19. Hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol will be used.
- Intense cleaning will be done before the pool opens and in between each session.
- Physical barriers or guides will be utilized to show good social distancing, for example, lane lines in the water, tape on the decks, floors, and sidewalks, and cones and ropes to show distance allowances. This is to ensure that our patrons and staff stay at least 6 feet apart from those they don't live with, both in and out of the water.
- There will be a one way exit in the bathrooms and one way exit out.
- Staff will wear face coverings when necessary.
- Tubes will be single riders only unless from the same family household.
- Signs will be posted in high vision areas to remind people to stop the spread of COVID.
- There will be one designated entrance and one designated exit.

## **OUTDOOR SPLASH PAD GUIDELINES”**

### **Postings will be placed in front of the splash pad.**

- Signs will be placed to maintain a physical distance of 6 feet with anyone you do not live with while using the splash pad.
- It is encouraged to have spacing and take turns while the use of activities.
