

R.C. Park Permit To Serve Alcohol In The Park

Any group or organization wishing to serve and consume fermented beverages such as beer and/or wine coolers in the Richland Center City Parks must comply with the following rules:

1. All alcohol served in the park must be served and consumed in the shelter or designated area.
2. No alcohol may be sold on this permit in the park.
3. Alcohol will not be served to minors.
4. All groups and organizations should apply for a permit to serve alcohol at least 30 days prior to usage.
5. All groups and organizations must clean up their area and shelter before leaving.
6. Glass bottles are prohibited in the park.
7. Permits may be obtained at the Community Center / Parks & Grounds Office. Hours are 8AM to 5PM, Monday through Friday, or by an appointment.
8. Only the Richland Center Parks & Grounds Board will issue permits.
9. It is your group or organization's responsibility to comply with these rules. Failure to comply with the above rules will be the loss of future permits
